The Office of the State Engineer, on behalf of Department of Game, Fish, & Parks, is soliciting Statements of Interest from firms interested in providing professional services for work related to production water improvements at Blue Dog State Fish Hatchery located in the North East part of South Dakota, near the town of Waubay.

The scope of this project will include construction of an iron and manganese removal system for production water, a filtration system to prevent Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) transmission and a vehicle decontamination wash area. The production water supply has high manganese/iron content that reduces the overall efficiency of the facility; a high volume treatment system is envisioned to help correct the water quality.

The second aspect of this project is a water filtration or treatment system and equipment wash down station that will protect the Blue Dog Hatchery from AIS. The initial phase of the work includes a study of options; design limitations, repair and maintenance costs, operational costs, contacting similar reference installations and project costs. The second phase will consist of schematic design/estimates; the third phase will be design development/estimates and finally bidding/management of the construction project.

The construction schedule will be established if the study phase finds it feasible and funding becomes available.

Firms wishing to be considered for providing professional services for this project should send a Statement of Interest that outlines their qualifications and experience. Statements of Interest should include at a minimum:

- Specialized expertise, capabilities and technical competence as demonstrated by the proposed approach and methodology to meet the project requirements; 50%
- Resources available to perform the work, including any specialized services, within the specified time limits for the project; 10%


- Record of past performance, including price and cost data from previous projects, quality of work, ability to meet schedules, cost control, and contract administration; 5%
- Availability to the project locale; 10%
- Familiarity with the project locale; 5%
- Proposed project management techniques; 5%
- Ability and proven history in handling special project constraints; 15%

A short-list of three firms shall be selected by the project engineer and members of the Department of Game, Fish, & Parks based upon the firm's Statement of Interest. These three firms will be asked to interview before the Building Committee before a final selection is made.
